Sense of Place:

Listed on the National Historic Register, the Casa Marina has been drawing visitors to the Florida Keys since 1920. Built by railroad magnate Henry Flagler as his final resort in Florida, Casa Marina became a cultural escape and playground for artists, dignitaries, royalty and the ultra-rich. Today, the resort continues its legendary reputation for style and sophistication, having recently completed a dramatic \$43 million enhancement that has touched every aspect of this iconic island haven, from accommodations and lobby to pool deck and meeting space.

Nestled along the southern edge of the island, Casa Marina shares an ideal location along Key West's largest private beach with sister property: The Reach Resort.

Accommodations:

311 newly renovated guest rooms and suites blend existing architecture with modern décor and amenities to offer a light and airy repose. Accents include pillow-top mattresses with plush linens, flat-screen televisions, sectional sleep sofas, dining/recreational tables with captains' chairs, Italian ceramic tile floors accented by earth-tone area rugs, multi-line telephones, mini-refrigerators, iHome clock-radios, in-room safe, power converters and wireless high-speed Internet connectivity. The majority of guestrooms offer oceanfront balconies or patios.

Restaurants:

The Sun Sun: This open-air, wood pavilion venue offers a casual, laid-back ambiance enhanced by extraordinary views of the Atlantic Ocean, and serves up a menu of island fare, including sandwiches, salads and seafood. Open daily for lunch and dinner.

Rambler's Lounge: Just off the main lobby, this social hot spot boasts a menu of wine, champagne and Key West's first Absinthe Bar. Menu is tapas style.

Rambler's Provisions Company: Grab coffee, ice cream and sandwiches to-go, or stock up on signature souvenirs, gifts and resort logo apparel.

Strip House: Located at sister property – The Reach Resort – Strip House is an island outpost of the famous Manhattan steak restaurant.

For guests opting to dine in the comfort of their suite, room service is available. The resort is also within walking distance to the numerous restaurants and cafés along Key West's famed Duval Street.

Recreation:

Beach & Pool: Two spacious reflecting pools and a 1,100-foot private beach offer sunbathing and hammocks.

Water Sports: The resort works directly with Key West Water Sports – located on the beach – to provide a full menu of ocean activities: boat trips, scuba diving, snorkeling, deep-sea and sport fishing, and a one-of-a-kind dolphin encounter. Equipment rentals are also available: jet skis, kayaks, fun boats, sun cats, windsurfers, bicycles and scooters.

Spa: A selection of relaxing and therapeutic treatments – from classic Swedish massage to reflexology – are available at The Massage Studio.

Additional Activities: A state-of-the-art fitness center are onsite, while nearby activities include three lighted tennis courts, the Rees Jones designed Key West Golf Club, Key West Aquarium, Key West Light House and a plethora of historical museums and art galleries.

Conference and Banquet Facilities:
